### **Apago Participates in JDF Interoperability Tour at Print 05**

Company Showcases New and Upgraded Products Featuring JDF Support

Chicago, IL—September 9, 2005—Apago Inc., a software developer for the graphic arts and document management industries, announces its participation in the JDF Interoperability Tour at Print 05. The tour will make stops at participating vendors' booths to demonstrate how various technologies can be seamlessly integrated through the Job Definition Format, a standard designed to simplify information exchange among various applications and systems. At Apago's booth, #7265, during the Front-end/Prepress segment of the Interoperability Tour, attendees will learn about streamlined electronic document management and publication workflows. Attendees can see first-hand how companies such as *The Atlanta Journal-Constitution* and Time Inc. use Apago's technology to create, manipulate, and repurpose PDF files, especially in high-volume and complex workflows that can routinely process thousands of pages. The JDF Interoperability Tour includes a stop at Apago's booth. Tours start at 1 PM each day.

"Apago has been actively involved in the development of the JDF standard for the last two years, and we are excited to be a part of the JDF Interoperability Tour at Print 05. During the JDF tour, Apago will demonstrate a new product, Cluster Workflow, and an upgrade to PDF Enhancer. Cluster Workflow is an innovative solution for creating reliable and highly scalable workflows for prepress, magazine and newspaper publishers, and printers. The server-based Apago Cluster Workflow features a network queuing system with sophisticated scheduling and fault-tolerance that maximizes the resources of each computer within the cluster. The solution removes real-world production bottlenecks and avoids the complexity of solutions using multi-tiered hot-folders or simplistic load-balancing.

PDF Enhancer is an industry-leading application for optimizing, repurposing, merging, stamping, imposing, and securing PDF documents. The upgrade adds several major new features including OS X support, font repair, selective color correction, and digital signatures.
